

BALDUCCI Luigi

Was born in Corato in the Kingdom of Naples on 10th January 1804.
He took his vows as a Redemptorist in Ciorani on 9th May 1824

and was ordained priest in Cava dei Tirreni on 22nd December 1827. Shortly after his ordination he was appointed to teach moral theology in the studendate, then in Benevento. While there he won the esteem of Cardinal Gioacchino Pecci, the governor, who was to become Leo XIII. From 1855 to 1869 he was consultor to the Rector Major, Father Celestino Berruti, during the time the Congregation was divided. He died in Pagani on 18th February 1883.
