HELD Frederick von (de) Was born in Brunn am Gebirge in the archdiocese of Vienna on 17th July 1799 and was a disciple of St. Clement Hofbauer. He joined

ordained priest also in Vienna on 21st August 1823. He was appointed first superior of the Belgian province in 1841, having responsibility also for the houses in Holland and America. He established the first Redemptorist house in England in 1843 and preached missions in that country and in Ireland. He visited America in 1845.
